1. Approval of the December minutes

New business:

1. Curt Hunter summarized new developments regarding the College International Programs.
 - a. Overall, the College international exposure is limited and the Dean's Office would like to expand the College international footprint and provide international study and work opportunities to both students and faculty.
 - b. Curt detailed two recent developments regarding the College's international footprint
 - i. Association with SKKU (Sungkyunkwan University) in Korea
 - ii. CIMBA (Consortium of Universities for International Studies) Program
 - c. Mary Spreen and Shari Piekarski complemented Curt's comments with additional details regarding both programs. Mary Spreen agreed to deliver to the EFC more detailed information regarding the CIMBA program.
2. Gary Russell discussed current events in the Faculty Senate
 - a. Smoking Ban measure was recently passed and will be made effective July 1st, 2009.
 - b. The Faculty Senate is monitoring the Provost search and candidates are expected to visit campus during Spring break.
 - c. Details on the recent establishment of a Research Professor Track
 - d. Informed that the Faculty Senate approved the motion that the March 24th-28th week will be "Peace Week" at the University of Iowa
 - e. Informed the EFC of proposed changes to the university code regulating consensual relationships.
3. The Elected Faculty Council tentatively scheduled a meeting for February 19th with the Deans and the SOM, to discuss concentrations and upcoming items regarding the MBA-PM program.
