

EFC DECISION

Honors Pledge on Student Exams

All students enrolled in classes under the control of the Tippie College of Business must signify agreement with an Honor Pledge on examinations. This requirement affects all programs (undergraduate, MBA and doctoral) and all locations (both on and off the Iowa City campus).

The pledge will read as follows: “I have neither given nor received assistance on this exam.”

Instructors may implement this requirement in a variety of ways: by having students write out and sign the pledge, by having students sign their name below a pre-printed pledge, by answering a multiple choice question containing the pledge, or (in the case of exams sent by electronic means) by having students type out the pledge followed by the student’s typed name.

Further, the EFC directs the Directors and Deans of the various Tippie College of Business programs (undergraduate, MBA and doctoral) to include a discussion of the honor code and the exam pledge requirement during the orientation of new students.
