Accelerated Admission Requirements

- ___ Complete a minimum of 12 UI hours but no more than 59 hours
 - ___ Complete 3 prereq courses (22M:17, 22S:8, and 6E:1 or 6E:2)
 - ___ Earn a UI, cumulative, and prerequisite* GPA of 2.75 or higher
 - ___ Earn no grade lower than a C in any prerequisite course
- *The prerequisite GPA will be calculated using grades from all the prerequisite courses taken.

Standard Admission Requirements

- ___ Complete 60 semester hours
- ___ Complete all 6 prerequisite courses
- ___ Earn a UI, cumulative, and prerequisite GPA of 2.75 or higher
- ___ Earn no grade lower than a C in any prerequisite course
- ___ Submission of the online application by the deadline:
 - April 1 (summer and fall applicants)
 - November 1 (spring applicants)

Additional Graduation Requirements:

Note: totals on your degree audit for semester hours, GPA, and residence requirements (#1-#11) do **not** include current registration.

- ___ **120 Total Hours** (see #2 on degree audit)
- ___ **48 Business Hours** (see #4 on degree audit)
 - Includes all 06 courses except 6E:001 and 6E:002.
 - Must include 24 UI business hours (see #6 on degree audit).
- ___ **60 Non-Business Hours** (see #8 on degree audit)
 - Includes all non-06 courses, 6E:001, and 6E:002.
- ___ **College of Business Residency** (see #11 on degree audit)
 - 30 sh at UI after admission to the College of Business.
- ___ **GPA Requirement** (see #1, #3, #5, #7, #9, and #10 on degree audit)
 - 2.0 (average) GPA in all courses, UI courses, business courses, UI business courses, major courses, and UI major courses.
- ___ **Degree Application**
 - Submit application on ISIS after completion of final semester registration. The Registrar determines if requirements are met.
