- Completion of five prerequisite courses with a 2.75 GPA
- A cumulative GPA of 2.75
- 24 semester hours of college credit
- No instances of academic misconduct
- Completion of an online application by May 1 for fall admission or December 1 for spring admission (subsequent summer courses will not be considered in the fall admission decision.)
