John Miclot is an entrepreneur and venture capitalist in the healthcare space. He was formerly the president and CEO of LinguaFlex, a company focused on treatment for sleep-disordered breathing. He brings nearly 30 years of health care industry experience and leadership to the advisory board.

Prior to leading LinguaFlex, he served as CEO of Tengion, Executive in Residence at Warburg Pincus, and in an executive role at Philips Home Healthcare Solutions following the acquisition of Respironics Inc. by Royal Philips.

Miclot spent ten years in senior roles at Respironics, ultimately serving as president and CEO from 2003 to 2008. While in that role, he led Respironics to record annual revenues of more than \$1 billion. He joined Respironics in 1998 when it acquired Healthdyne Technologies Inc., a medical device company.

Miclot served in various positions at Healthdyne from 1995 to 1998, including senior vice president of sales and marketing. Earlier in his career, he held sales and marketing roles at Medex, Ohmeda, Baxter Edwards, and DeRoyal Industries.

He has served on a number of public and private boards including Wright Medical, Dentsply, ev3, and Breathe Technologies. He has also served on numerous non-profit boards. He is an active member of YPO/YPO Gold.

He currently serves as a Director of Dynamics Inc, McGowan Institute of Regenerative Medicine, and the Pittsburgh Zoo and PPG Aquarium.

Miclot received a BBA in marketing from the University of Iowa in 1981.
