

Tippie Quick Guides

How to stay on track to declare major(s) and major(s) pre-requisites

1. Complete or in-progress with all required **major declaration courses**:
 - **ECON:1200 – Macroeconomics**
 - **ACCT:2100 – Financial Accounting**
2. Review Majors in Tippie. Prioritize specific **major pre-requisites** for your intended major of choice in your academic plan. Students will not be on track to take major specific courses if they have not completed our major declaration courses and major pre-requisites. Below is a list of key major pre-requisites.

Majors in Tippie	Major Pre-requisites to Prioritize in Academic Plan
Accounting & Corporate Accounting	ACCT:2100
Business Analytics	BAIS:3005 & BAIS:2800
Economics & Analytical Economics	ECON:1100 & ECON:1200
Entrepreneurship	MGMT:2000 & MGMT:2100
Finance	FIN:3000
Management (Human Resources & Leadership)	MGMT:2000 & MGMT:2100
Marketing	MKTG:3000 & BAIS:2800
Risk Management & Insurance	FIN:3400

**Accounting no longer requires ACCT:2200 as a pre-requisite for some major level courses.*

3. Students not admitted to Tippie must request access for major level courses by filling out the Pre-Admission Requirement Form.
 - Students are granted special permission if they're on track for admission, complete/in-progress with pre-requisites for admission, major declaration courses are complete/in-progress, and complete/in-progress with major course pre-requisites.
