Chris A. Cox has served as Senior Vice President and Chief Accounting Officer of AMC Entertainment Holdings, Inc. since June 2010. AMC is the world's largest movie exhibition company, operating a global footprint across the United States and Europe, with approximately 855 theatres and 9640 screens. Cox previously served as Vice President and Chief Accounting Officer beginning in 2002, following his appointment as Vice President and Controller in 2000.

In addition to serving on the executive team at AMC, a New York Stock Exchange-listed company headquartered in Leawood, Kansas, Cox serves as a director on the holding companies for AMC's European subsidiary, Odeon Cinemas Group, as well as the U.K.-based operating companies.

Prior to joining AMC, Cox served as Director of Corporate Accounting for The Dial Corporation. Earlier in his career, he spent ten years in the Assurance practice at PricewaterhouseCoopers.

Actively engaged in the community, Cox currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Kansas City and is involved in various roles with his church. Outside of his professional and civic commitments, he enjoys sports and outdoor activities, including competitive barbecue contests, and remains actively involved with his family's farm in southern Iowa.

Cox received a Bachelor of Business Administration degree in Accounting and Finance from the University of Iowa's Tippie College of Business in 1989. He currently serves on the Tippie Advisory Board and previously served on the college's Professional Accounting Council. He was the 2021 recipient of the University of Iowa Outstanding Accounting Alumnus of the Year.
