



## **Jeremy Gosch**

**Chairman of the Board and CEO**  
**Hy-Vee, Inc.**

Jeremy Gosch serves as Chairman of the Board and CEO of Hy-Vee, Inc., a \$14 billion retailer operating more than 560 retail locations across the Midwest. Hy-Vee is Iowa's largest employer, with more than 70,000 employees across retail, healthcare, supply chain and technology.

Gosch started his career with Hy-Vee in 1995 as a part-time clerk at the Coralville, Iowa, store and was named store director at Eldora, Iowa, in 2002. He led stores in several communities before joining Hy-Vee's executive leadership team in 2012 as assistant vice president, operations, for Hy-Vee's northeast region. He was promoted through various executive leadership roles in merchandising, marketing, strategy and operations before being named president and chief operating officer in 2021. In 2022, he was promoted to CEO and vice chairman of Hy-Vee, becoming only the fifth CEO in the company's history. In 2024, Gosch was appointed chairman and CEO of Hy-Vee.

In 2024, Gosch was named to Drug Store News' list of 50 Most Influential People in Retail Health and was also recognized as the Iowa Grocery Industry Association's Retail Leader of the Year.

Gosch currently serves as an executive committee director for FMI – The Food Industry Association and serves on the Retail Industry Leaders Association board of directors. Gosch also served on the National Association of Chain Drug Stores (NACDS) board. Locally, Gosch serves as a member of the Iowa Business Council and as a member of the Greater Des Moines Partnership's Executive Committee and Board of Directors.

Gosch earned a BBA in Finance from the University of Iowa's Tippie College of Business in 1997.
