Perry Glassgow is the vice president and controller of Harley-Davidson Inc. (HDI). He is responsible for the accounting, financial planning and analysis, financial reporting, and cost management of the company.

Prior to his current role, Perry was vice president and treasurer of HDI where he was responsible for all treasury, cash management, and capital market activities. In addition to his treasury duties, he also served as the interim chief financial officer of Harley-Davidson Financial Services Inc. (HDFS) from November 2007 to April 2009 and interim president of HDFS from May to July 2009.

Before assuming the treasurer position at HDI in 2007, he was vice president-finance and treasurer of HDFS and a member of the HDFS Executive Leadership Team.
