Tom Kloet has served as the chairman of the board of the Nasdaq Stock Market LLC since 2016 and on the Board of Directors of Nasdaq Inc. and Northern Trust's Mutual Funds (Northern Funds and Northern Institutional Funds) since 2015. He chairs the audit and risk committee at Nasdaq and serves on the audit and governance committees at Northern Funds and Northern Institutional Funds.

Kloet was CEO of the TMX Group from 2008 until his retirement in October 2014. Prior to that, he served as Senior Executive Vice President and COO of the American Zone and its successor, Newedge Group.

From 2000 to 2002, Kloet served as the first chief executive officer and executive director of Singapore Exchange Limited (SGX). At SGX, he led the exchange through its transformation from a mutual utility to a commercial entity and through its initial public offering and listing on its own exchange in November 2000.

Prior positions include work as senior managing director for ABN AMRO Inc., where he was responsible for all operating activity of the global derivatives business and managing subsidiary brokerage companies in Singapore, Hong Kong, Tokyo, and Sydney. He served as chief operating officer at Credit Agricole Futures Inc. in Chicago and was an executive officer of its parent company, Segespar Capital Members Inc.

Kloet was a member of the Board of Directors of the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME) from 1996 until 2000. He also served on the Board of Directors of the Boston Options Exchange (BOX), the CBOE Futures Exchange, the Chicago Stock Exchange, the Bermuda Stock Exchange, the Investment Industry Regulatory Organization of Canada (IIROC), the National Futures Association, and the World Federation of Exchanges (WFE). He previously served on the nonprofit boards of Elmhurst College and Edward-Elmhurst Healthcare, as well as the United States Commodity Futures Trading Commission's Market Risk Advisory Committee.

A certified public accountant, Kloet is a member of AICPA. He graduated with a BBA degree from the University of Iowa in 1980.
